RE: Science Set Changes – Post-Easter

As previously communicated, changes to Year 10 science sets will take place following the Easter break. These adjustments are based on a range of factors including recent assessments, classwork, effort, and class dynamics. From the start of the summer term:

- **Sets 1 and 2** will follow the **higher tier** of the combined science course.
- **Sets 3, 4 & 5** will include a **mix of higher and foundation tier students**.

All students will have flexibility to move between sets based on their progress and following future assessments.

All classes are currently aligned in terms of curriculum coverage, so no student will miss any content because of any move. New timetables will be issued on the first day back after Easter, and teachers will closely monitor students to ensure a smooth transition and provide appropriate support.
